(Must be 14 years of age or older to participate.)

Valuable prizes and trophies will be awarded for highest scores and runners-up for men and women in both the **League Bowler Division** and the **Non-League Bowler Division**.

Tournament Rules

This is an individual event. A maximum of 110 bowlers will be accommodated.

There will be two divisions – league bowlers (with a USBC Member Number) and non-league bowlers. The league division bowler will use their book average to determine their handicap and the non-league bowlers will not use a handicap. The high score for the total of three games will determine the winner in the non-league division. The high score of three games plus handicap will determine the winner in the league division.

Handicaps will be calculated as 100% of the difference between 225 and the entering average.

The average used to establish a handicap will be:

- A. The highest of any of the following:
 - 1. A qualified fall league average as of December 31, 2010
 - 2. Season-end average from a 2009-2010 qualified league
 - 3. Highest 2010 summer league average (minimum 21 games)
- B. If none of the above is available, an average established as of February 28, 2011 may be used (provided 21 games or more have been played).
- C. If none of the above exists, the bowler must enter with a 225 average.

There is no minimum entering average and we do not use negative handicaps.

No entry will be accepted without entry fees. No refunds will be made after the entry has been received and scheduled to bowl. Late bowlers will receive 0 for each frame missed.

All entries must be received by August 1, 2011. Late entries will not be accepted nor will there be registration on the day of the event.

Dress Code: While competing, proper attire shall include shirts with sleeves, dress slacks, jeans or dress shorts. No tank tops, denim shorts or cutoffs, swimsuits, spandex, dresses or hats. **NO OBSCENE ATTIRE.** All issues with regard to proper attire will be decided upon by tournament management.

All 3 games will be bowled on the same pair of lanes.

Scoring errors: After a score has been recorded, it cannot be changed unless there is an obvious error in scoring or calculation. Obvious errors must be corrected by a tournament official immediately upon discovery. Questionable errors shall be decided by tournament management.
