

A MESSAGE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

The recent crisis surrounding the spread of COVID-19 is affecting our most vulnerable neighbors. Across the Pass, the demands for food relief are increasing. Closed businesses result in employees being put on unpaid leave, causing additional hardship for food-insecure families. Measures intending to reduce transmission, such as guarantines and asking vulnerable populations to stay home, are forcing seniors and immunocompromised people to rely on expensive and limited grocery delivery services.

WHATS HAPPENING IN THE KITCHEN

BANNING

The Tuesday and Friday Banning kitchens are busy making 120+ sack lunches and bags of food at each kitchen each week. Additionally, they are preparing 80 sack lunches for Immanuel Christian church to distribute to the homeless and 40 sack lunches for Ramsey Street Village. At this time, the Banning kitchen has also provided free haircuts to 25 of our guests thanks to Mike Grovea and Stacy Strenger. There was also coordination with Home Base to provide incentives to the homeless at all our kitchens to participate in the 2020 census

BEALMONT

On Monday and Thursday, the kitchen is functioning at two levels. A team of 12 to 15 volunteers are assembling 70 sack lunches to give to our regular guests. Then they are putting together another 70+ hot meals to have a representative pick up and deliver to the home bound residents at Sun Lakes, Beaumont Terrace and Liberty Village. Great teamwork gets it done so hats off to each and everyone in the kitchen.

CABAZON

During the pandemic shut down both our Monday and Thursday Cabazon kitchens are preparing 80 sack lunches for distribution to our guests along with 80 bags of groceries. For both kitchens we utilize only about ½ of our regular volunteers to prepare and distribute lunches and groceries. At the Thursday kitchen Immanuel Christian church comes and picks up 40 additional sack lunches to bring to the homeless in Cabazon.
